Staff will be on hand at all three campuses and online to help with enrolments at sessions on Saturday and Sunday, ahead of the commencement of Semester 1 next week.

Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Students and Education) Professor David Sadler said it was an exciting and very busy time of year for students and staff.

“We have thousands of students coming to the University to begin or continue their educational journey with us,” Professor Sadler said.
