***ArtRage 2007* exhibition hits Hobart**

The University of Tasmania's Tasmanian School of Art is delighted to be hosting *ArtRage 2007*, the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery's (QVMAG) vibrant exhibition of secondary school student artwork.

ArtRage 2007 includes artwork from 71 secondary art students from around the state.

The featured works were selected by co-curators Education Officer Helene Weeding and Marisa Molin from the QVMAG's Graphics Department.

The exhibition is diverse in media and subject matter, featuring digital and traditional black-and-white photographs, sculpture, painting, drawing and graphic design work.

ArtRage 2007 also includes an Examiners' Choice: one student selected by the TCE State Art Assessment Panel to exhibit their complete body of artwork. This year Ariel Pascoe, from Hellyer College, will have her exemplary body of work and the associated support material exhibited in full at *ArtRage 2007*.

ArtRage 2007 is supported by the QVMAG, the Burnie Regional Gallery and the UTAS Tasmanian School of Art.
