Clean-up begins at UTAS Cradle Coast campus

A clean-up is underway at the UTAS Cradle Coast campus following yesterday's thunderstorm which battered the region.

Certain areas of the campus which were affected by flash flooding have been cordoned off. No teaching has been cancelled, with classes being relocated to accommodate the situation.
