International law expert returns home to deliver free lecture

Former Burnie boy Tim McCormack will present the UTAS Alumni/Red Cross Address in Burnie on **Wednesday 31 July**.

Professor McCormack will present the address, *From the Netherlands to Van Diemen's Land and back again: A Tasmanian perspective on the pursuit of global justice* at the UTAS Cradle Coast Campus.

Prof McCormack is the Special Adviser on International Humanitarian Law to the prosecutor of the International Criminal Court in The Hague. He is an Adjunct Professor of Law at UTAS Faculty of Law and a Professor of Law at the Melbourne Law School.
