## **Childhood memories revisited in new exhibition**

CHILDHOOD recollections explored through images and objects forms part of a new exhibition to be opened at the UTAS Cradle Coast campus on Friday, May 2.

*Clear Vision: A Childhood Memory* is the latest exhibition by Malcom Bywaters, Director of The Academy Gallery, UTAS Inveresk, and features recollections through paintings, sketches and artist books.

The exhibition is part of Malcom's long-term project exploring the relationship between memory, childhood and home, where in *Clear Vision: A Childhood Memory* these themes are looked at through images and objects associated with his rural upbringing in Western Victoria.

Among the exhibition's pieces is a large cardboard model aeroplane, reminiscent of the Tiger Moth biplane Malcom flew in as a passenger at the age of seven.

The exhibition will be officially opened by local artist Patrick Grieve from 6pm on May 2 at the campus' gallery foyer, Mooreville Road, Burnie. The exhibition will run until Friday, June 6.
